### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will enable the City of Arcadia to restore this historic and iconic building and return it to its original use as a functioning city hall. It will also contribute to a greater sense of pride for a community which has struggled economically for many years. The building is the major image within the city's logo and it is listed on the register of National Historic Structures.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Elected officials and staff offices will be returned to the building. The current building was makeshift immediately after Hurricane Charley and has continued in limited function since Hurricane Charley of 2004. There are no offices for elected officials within the current building.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

City administration, finance, city clerk, community development activities, human resources, and code enforcement.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire city population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

To return the building to its original use as it is currently not in adequate condition to function as such. Plans for the building have already been prepared by noted, certified Historic Preservation Architect Dr. Linda Stevenson. The preparation of those plans was paid through a Division of Historic Resources Small Matching grant of \$50,000.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Standard contract penalties will be sufficient.
