12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Omega Lamplighters are requesting funding to provide additional mentorship to at-risk youth in Leon, Escambia, Duval, Orange, St. Lucie, Hillsborough and Miami-Dade County. Funds will be used to expand access for youth to participate in after-school mentorship programs, college tours, training and development.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funding will be used to provide after-school reading, mentorship, and life changing family services to at-risk youth in high crime juvenile crime areas throughout Leon, Duval, Escambia, Hillsborough, St. Lucie, and Miami-Dade County.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Individual, group and family focused counseling, crisis intervention counseling, college preparatory and skills training, social skills training, prevention and diversion services, recreational services to at-risk youth in Leon, Duval, Escambia, Hillsborough, St. Lucie and Miami-Dade County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, preschool students and grade school students will be the target population served by this project. Omega Lamplighters anticipate servicing 1,318 at-risk youth.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Omega Lamplighters will focus on improving quality of education, reducing substance abuse and diverting at-risk youth from the criminal & juvenile justice systems. This project will increase quality of after-school reading programs, access to individual mentors and services for at-risk youth.



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f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Paying back 10% of the contracted amount back to the State of Florida for not meeting the goals outlined by the Department of Juvenile Justice or any regulating body.
