#### 12. Program Performance

##### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The design of the pending drainage and roadway rehabilitation project is intended to provide a shovel ready construction project designed to reduce standing water resulting from rainfall events as no stormwater outfall currently exists for much of the area. Additionally, the design will incorporate roadway reconstruction/rehabilitation to address failing roadways throughout the community.

##### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds are requested to provide for surveying and engineering design of needed drainage and roadway improvements throughout the northeast residential area of the village to provide shovel ready design needed to reduce chronic roadway and residential flooding, as well as to repair and rebuild failing roadways throughout the community.

##### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The design of the pending drainage and roadway rehabilitation project directly impacting the village residents in the community by reducing standing waters resulting from rainfall events as no stormwater outfall currently exists for much of the area. Additionally, safer roads will directly impact residents by reducing the potential for accidents and by enhancing emergency vehicle access.

##### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is a predominately minority residential population with an average income level mainly below median average income for the State. The area encompasses an estimated 3,500 residents.

##### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Design of a drainage and roadway improvement project that will create a stormwater management system for portions of the village and restore failed drainage for the remainder. The community currently floods in many areas during afternoon rains, with standing water remaining for days in several locations. Design funds will assist in creating a shovel ready project that will ultimately result in stormwater management and conveyance and restored roadways. Benefits can be measured by a lack of standing water, confirmation of drainage, and roadway design improvements. Additionally, failing roadways can increase the likelihood of traffic accidents due to loss of vehicular control and rehabilitating these roads will directly result in enhanced safety. A measure of traffic flow and accidents would be a potential measure of traffic safety resulting from completion of the final construction of this project.

**f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?**

As this request is for design and surveying for a proposed drainage and roadway rehabilitation project, penalties should consist of reimbursement for the disbursed design funding.
