The redundant 20-inch force main and lined existing 20-inch force main provide operational flexibility and resiliency by allowing the City's wastewater collection system that serves the southeast portion of the City and the barrier island to continue to operate continuously if a portion of either pipe is impacted significantly reducing the risk of residential exposure to sanitary sewer overflows.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Wastewater collection and treatement.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Resident in the southeast portion of Palm Beach County served by the Clty's wastewater facility as well as reduction of wastewater pollutants potentially discharged in the environment, on residential property, and into of waters of the State from sanitary sewer overflows over an ~5 square mile area.
