12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The City's current water pumping facility is 30+ years old and not optimally located to provide the needed pressures in the northeast portion of the City. The northeast part of the City has seen and will continue to see substantial economic growth including housing developments, commercial and industrial developments. The City is going to build a new Booster Pump Station Facility to improve pressure for peak demand and also provide the needed fire flow. Also included in this project will be improvements to the chemical system and include a CAT 5 building to house staff during an emergency event so they can monitor the water system and also construct an emergency interconnect with Sarasota County which will supply water to the City if for any reason the City's water supply is interrupted due to an emergency.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The purpose of the funds is to assist in funding the construction of the new Booster Pump Station. The northeast portion of the City has seen economic growth and includes housing, commercial and also industrial businesses. The booster pump station will provide the needed pressure to accommodate the continued economic growth. The City is including a CAT 5 control building so staff can monitor the water supply system during a storm event.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The citizens will have the needed pressures especially during peak demand and will have the needed fire flow which is needed for commercial and industrial growth in the area. Also the emergency interconnect with the County would allow water to be supplied if for any reason the City's system is damaged during an emergency event. The CAT 5 control facility will also allow the water flows to be monitored during a storm or emergency event.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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The project targets the entire City's population which is 23,985 as of July 2019.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Service line pressure and chlorine residuals are monitored in the affected area to ensure compliance with standards. The Cat 5 building and interconnect will benefit the City in the event of a outage due to a storm event or other emergencies that would effect the City's water supply.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
