a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of this project is to provide a youth empowerment center that equips preschool through middle school youth (VPK-8) with the effective skills to graduate high school and become productive citizens.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Programming will be provided that covers various subject matter which focuses on personal growth and development, life-skills training and career development.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

An after school program that will provide guidance and instruction on: Stewardship, leadership, public speaking, computer and information technology, health and recreation, money management, entrepreneurship, financial literacy including investing, savings and budgeting, arts and culture (i.e. photography, writing, and painting).

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Over 100 economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, and development disabled persons.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Increased work and study habits; improved initiative; increased creativity and innovation; increased test scores; improved grads; improved school attendance (all of these factors are measures of higher engagement, improved performance, higher academic performance but not a measure of the quality of education as that is tied to the school the child attends).

Increased reading skills, mathematical skills, access to career training and vocational skills, intervention programming through successful engagement with community partners of similar alignment via City and County resources including Non-Profit sector.

Pre- and post mental health

assessments measuring implementation of behavior modifications pre/post analysis; measuring the six underlying constructs of mental health among youth including relationships, program effectiveness, self-control, empathy, communication and decision-making.

Provision of transportation to and from the program.
