12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Meaningful employment of the veterans that are served, reducing the likelihood of suicide, substance abuse, and homelessness.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Two weeks of classroom proprietary training (live and virtual), one-on-one coaching, mentoring, salary negotiation techniques, networking events, resume assistance, mock interviews, introductions to people within their field of employment, and a graduation.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The total economic impact of the Florida region from the Operation New Uniform program is \$13.4 million annually.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Unemployed, underemployed, and transitioning veterans of all eras. In each classroom (live and virtual) will be approximately 75 students, with over 1,500 veterans and families served over the course of a year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit for each student is to obtain a fulfilling and stable career.

Measured are time to placement, annual salary, industry, and position of each student that goes through the Finding the Uniform program.

Operation New Uniform has a 97% success of placement within 4 months of graduating the program.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?



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In the event that Operation New Uniform does not meet deliverables they will not be eligible to request funding for the next year.
