An enhanced mobility experience for students and other pedestrians.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funding aims to provide St. Johns County citizens a direct benefit by improving the pedestrian mobility system service level.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

An increased level of service (LOS) to students and other pedestrians after improvements are completed.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Students and the general population; greater than 800 people.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected outcomes: 1) The improvements will enhance the mobility network, planning for additional capacity for current and anticipated growth in the area. Measurement: Annual pedestrian counts after the improvements are completed.
2) Increase construction related jobs and spending on goods and services. Measurement: Construction wages/annual average wage.
3) It is anticipated the project will immediately create at least 10 construction-related job opportunities. Measurement: Successful audit of contractor's employment records.
