School teachers who are certified in reading will provide after school tutoring to improve the reading deficiencies of the identified students.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Students in Kindergarten through grade 5 enrolled in a public school who either scored below a Level 3 on the English Language Arts (ELA) assessment in the prior year or who the district has determined through progress monitoring to be below grade level and in need of additional reading intervention.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Students will improve their reading proficiency and be at or above grade level in reading. The student's assigned school district teacher will continue to measure the student performance via district approved diagnostics and progress monitoring assessments.



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f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The Department may withhold funding for a district until the district can demonstrate that tutors have been hired, tutors are meeting with students, or that progress monitoring is being conducted.
