a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The main street area of Crestview would be updated to allow for easier automobile and pedestrian traffic in the downtown area, allowing for increased economic opportunity in the area.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Upgrading of sidewalks, streets, and parking areas in the downtown area. Additionally, the project will provide for alternative ways for small businesses to serve their customers.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Additional parking, safer streets, safer sidewalks, and improvements to provide opportunities for downtown businesses to be successful.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will impact city and county residents within an 8 mile radius. The estimated population served is approximately 47,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The primary benefit of this project will be to improve the safety and experience of citizens while increasing the success of small businesses in the district. The success of this project will be measured in traffic accidents and through business occupancies.

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The City of Crestview will enforce liquidated damages on any and all contractors who fail to meet required timelines.
