4. Project/Program Description

The City of Destin is requesting funding to purchase equipment to manage storm water in substantial storm events. This equipment consists of 2 self priming cast iron pumps and multiple hoses.

During times of disaster the City staff must deploy personnel and resources to pump down approximately six closed basins (in some instances 24-hr a day for several days, up to a week.)
A closed basin is an area that cannot drain to a lower elevation under gravity as it is surrounded on all sides by higher elevations, a bowl if you will. The addition of these pumps will provide the City the means to restore the passability of roads and will prevent homes from flooding.
