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The Florida Housing Finance Corporation provided the City of Clearwater with \$1,034,546 in CARES Act funding for mortgage, rent, and housing assistance. The city was able to expend \$930,119 within the restricted timeframe and returned \$104,427 to the state.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Increase access to outdoor recreational space. Enhance Coachmane Park with new amenities, such as pedestrian and cyclist access, a children's playground, and an interactive water feature. Reduce impervious surface by three acres. New stormwater pond will increase stormwater retention capabilities on-site.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Musical and theatrical productions in the band shell provide access to the arts and draw local and regional audiences to visit downtown Clearwater. Outdoor recreation including a playground, an interactive water feature, walking and cycling paths, and open green space for free play.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Special events programming by the city's Parks & Recreation Department and Special Events staff.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will benefit no specific group. The enhanced waterfront and park will be accessible to residents, visitors, and artists. More than 800 individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

When completed, Imagine Clearwater will provide city residents and visitors with enhanced recreational space, improved access to the waterfront, and new playground amenities for children. The city will maintain records for event attendance and users of recreational space. All existing old sanitary sewer in the project area will be replaced and upgraded to current standards.
