12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds requested will aid the city in its efforts to finalize a full building renovation (inclusive of necessary building code updates) while maintaining proper historic preservation techniques. The city currently has structural repairs underway for the foundation and underground utilities.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The City of New Smyrna Beach will finalize the production of construction contract documents (inclusive of detailed construction plans and specifications) and advertise for competitive construction bids. The city will then identify the lowest responsible bidder and move to the construction phase for utilization of the state grant funds.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Residents and visitors will be able to continue to enjoy use of the 1924 historic Woman's Club facility for event purposes (such as weddings, conferences, recreation, and education, etc.).

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The immediate target population is residents of the City of New Smyrna Beach. However, nationwide interest and visitors can also be served for any event needs, but more importantly for historic preservation and recognition (inclusive of facility tours).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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The outcome for the City of New Smyrna Beach and residents will be to showcase the importance the city and residents place on preserving unique, historic, one-of-a-kind landmarks. The Woman's Club is nationally registered with the United States Department of the Interior - National Park Service. Measuring the outcome of this project will be by way of maintaining current national standing with the United States Department of the Interior - National Park Service while also providing proper aesthetic improvements so the facility can continue to be enjoyed and recognized for many more years to come.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If a contractor fails on their deliverables and/or performance, the city would attempt to remedy the situation by formally notifying the contractor of the discrepancy and allowing the contractor the option to correct. If discrepancy remains and proves unaddressed, the city reserves the right to terminate the contract and would transition the remaining scope of work to the 2nd most responsible bidder. The city also maintains in the overall construction contract language for liquidated damages that may incur if the contractor does not complete the project by the construction completion date. Standard contract penalties for the contract with the state are sufficient.
