a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Increased literacy in students in K-3rd grade.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Individualized and small group lessons and interactive instruction based on Systematic Instruction in Phonologic awareness, Phonics and Sight Words (SIPPS) curriculum. This is done in conjunction with iReady testing to determine reading levels and improvement.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct evidence-based reading instruction to struggling readers in grades K-4 with input from classroom teachers and reading coaches.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is elementary (K-3) students and teachers. The program is currently serving over 800 individuals currently.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

In the early elementary school grades, students learn to read so that they can read to learn in the higher grades. Unless children learn to read proficiently at the appropriate grade level, they cannot understand the textbooks used in all disciplines. This is measured through standardized tests, teacher evaluations, and iReady results.
