12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The new radio tower will connect the City's CCTV camera network to the Police Department's new Real Time Crime Center

part of the City's New Police Headquarters project currently in the Design Phase. The existing Radio Tower is adjacent to the

existing facility and cannot be relocated. Furthermore, the new Radio Tower will be a significant technological upgrade compared to the existing tower, allowing connectivity to an expanded CCTV network. This will improve safety in the City.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Radio Tower is required to allow the Police Department to proactively monitor the City's CCTV camera network and direct

officers to the appropriate location in a timely fashion when crimes, accidents, or dangerous situations are observed.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The service provided to Citizens is a proactive response by the Police Department to observed crimes, accidents, and dangerous situations.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All citizens living in the City, traveling through the City, or visiting the City will be safer due to this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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The Police Department expects a 20% or greater reduction in vehicle burglaries and property crimes in each area where new

CCTV cameras can be installed as a result of building the new radio tower. This will be measured by the number of property

crimes & vehicle burglary crimes in each area where CCTV cameras can be installed as a result of building the new radio tower, for a comparison period of 2 years before the tower is installed, and a period of 2 years after the new tower is installed.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The City will include liquidated and consequential damages in the project contracts.
