### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The city will repair pavement, install bike lanes, repair damaged curbs, and replace pedestrian ramps with ADA compliant ramps. The purpose of the improvements is to create connectivity and additional mobility options in compliance with the city's bicycle master plan and to improve vehicular and pedestrian travel.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The city will improve safety conditions for vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle travel by making improvements identified in section a. above.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The citizens will enjoy safer vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle travel upon completion of the project.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population of motorists and bicyclists who travel north and south on Flagler Drive is estimated to be in excess of 500 per day.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



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### be measured?

The benefits of this project are better travel and safety conditions for motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists. The methodology to measure the outcome will be based on observation, but will not be specifically measured. The improvements are expected to increase the use of the roads, bike lanes, and sidewalks due to improved conditions.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The city will include a liquidated damages provision in its contract to address any inexcusable delays. Standard contract penalties for the contract with the state are sufficient.
