Improvements consist of renovations of 3 baseball fields. The renovations will meet Little League baseball field standards consisting of turf replacement, grading/drainage improvements, irrigation modification/expansion, new bases/base lines/pitcher's mound, fencing and gates, backstops and safety nets. Upgrade of scoreboards, dugouts, bleachers, scorekeeper areas, bullpens and shade structures.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Complete renovations of 3 Little League baseball fields with all appurtenances located at the Bonita Springs Community Park.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The redevelopment of the baseball fields and appurtenance structures will provide a safe playing field for the youth of the Bonita Springs Community. Baseball teaches our youth ideals of honesty, integrity, courage, respect for authority and good sportsmanship. Our youth learn to become better equipped to handle a variety of situations and allow them to grow into future leaders.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

These improvements will target at-risk youth, preschool, grade school and high school children. The City expects to serve 200-400 children ranging in age from 4 to 16.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Little League will target age groups from 4 to 16 to improve their stamina, develop a sense of team work. Additionally, the youth of our community will improve their physical activity taking advantage to the outdoors.
