The specific purpose or goal of this project is to improve the quality of the City's stormwater lakes by removing accumulated pollution.

The City plans a \$30 million project over the next 10 years to dredge and/or treat the City's stormwater lakes to remove accumulated pollution and install best management practices within and around lakes. Options such littoral shelves, aeration, and filter marshes will be used.

The citizens will benefit from this project through the improved water quality after the stormwater is treated.
