1. Project Title	Clewiston Water System Infrastructure Improvements To Serve The Airglades Airport Project

#### 4. Project/Program Description

To provide an adequate potable water supply and meet fire flow protection requirements for future development of the Airglades International Airport and the U.S. 27 highway corridor between the airport and the City of Clewiston's public water supply system, water infrastructure improvements are necessary. An appropriately designed direct line six inch in diameter water feed needs to be constructed from a connection point with Clewiston's water system to the Hendry County owned half million gallon water storage tank located at the airport. The estimated cost of the needed improvements is approximately \$4.0 million. The City of Clewiston requests legislative funding of this project and proposes it be completed in partnership with Hendry County in like manner to the wastewater force main project currently planned to serve the airport.

#### 12. Program Performance

#### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The requested funds are necessary to ensure the provision of an adequate potable water supply and meet fire flow requirements for future development of the Airglades International Airport and the U.S. 27 highway corridor between the airport and the City of Clewiston's existing public water supply system. This will allow for improved water services to the affected area and provide the opportunity for much needed economic development to occur in a fiscally constrained county consistently with among the highest unemployment rates in the state of Florida.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

For any significant economic development to occur in this area, the installation of suitable infrastructure must be available to ensure an adequate water supply and that minimum fire flow requirements are met..

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Installation of the water line improvements will positively impact public health, safety and welfare by improving the capabilities for the provision of an adequate water supply and meet fire flow requirements for the affected area.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



The target population to be served by this project will directly include the AIA site and the U.S. 27 highway corridor between the airport and the City of Clewiston. Directly the approximately 15,000 population in areas served with public water supply in Clewiston and significant portions of eastern Hendry County will be benefited by improved fire flows and water pressure as a result of this project. Indirectly, the entirety of Hendry County's 40,000 population and portions of nearby Glades County will benefit from the enhanced economic development potential created by this project which will boost private investment and the creation of employment opportunities for the entire region. This is a much needed outcome in a financially disadvantaged county & municipality for an area designated as a rural area of economic concern & a rural area of opportunity.

# e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefits and outcomes of this project are improved public health, safety and welfare resulting from the installation of adequate potable water supply delivery system improvements to facilitate much needed economic development. The private economic investment and increased employment opportunities are anticipated to be very significant in a positive way for a rural Hendry County. As a result of this project, lower unemployment rates, higher prevailing wage rates and increased public sector revenues resulting from enhanced property values associated with new private investment are anticipated positive outcomes over time and are measurable.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

As these are public investments in infrastructure and provided that the City uses the funds appropriately under state agency oversight, no penalties should be incurred by the responsible local government agency.
