Executive Director/Project Head Salary and Benefits	Executive Director - Will oversee the daily operation and management of the program, write grants and fundraise to acquire additional funding and permanent funding sources, will meet with community leaders, organizations and elected officials as needed in order to establish the impactful community based outreach programs (education, health summits, workshops, etc) for the overal program.	65,000
Other Salary and Benefits	Executive Assistant - will report to the Executive Director, handle office administration duties, and oversee the community based outreach and program management (education, health summits, workshops) for one of the four counties (Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Palm Beach) that will be targeted by the program.	45,000

Salary and Benefits	A part time County Specific Coordinator will be assigned (20-25 hours per week) to each of the four counties (Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Palm Beach County). The executive Assistant will be the coordinator in one of the four counties and the other three county coordinators will be paid \$30,000 to work 20-25 hours per week to establish and manage the community based programs.	90,000

#### 12. Program Performance



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#### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific goal of the funds is to educate and collaborate with African American and Hispanic leaders, community organizations and fraternities/sororities in (Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Palm Beach Counties) on minority health disparities (i.e. the chronic illnesses that disproportionately affect the health of African Americans and Hispanics). Funding will be used to establish impactful community based programs that focus on prevention, early detection and treatment of chronic illnesses.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Community Based Programs (education, health summits and workshops) will be established and conducted in Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Palm Beach Counties to help community leaders, organizations and fraternities/sororities assist their respective African American and Hispanic communities with programs that educate, prevent, manage and encourage early detection of chronic illnesses and diseases.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Health Workshops and Summits will be Conducted in the four counties (Orange, Osceola, Seminole, Palm Beach) to educate citizens on how chronic illnesses impact specific communities and to help establish programs that prevent and assist with early detection of chronic illnesses and then how to manage the chronic illnesses and improve health outcomes after a chronic disease begins to affect someone.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population will be greater than 1,000 individuals and mainly consist of African American and Hispanic Leaders, community organizations and fraternities and sororities, and church congregations in four counties (Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Palm Beach) County.

## e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduction in number of people missing work, number of people being hospitalized and the number of people that may be affected by the onset of a chronic illness (cancer, cardiovascular disease, diabetes, asthma, obesity, low birth weight babies, etc). Cancer will include prostrate, breast and colon cancer. Teaching citizens about the causes of chronic illnesses, helping them to understand their family medical history and how to prevent the onset of chronic illnesses, encouraging them to have annual physicals that might detect chronic diseases, and how to manage a chronic illness will improve the physical health of individuals, keep them out of the hospital and reduce time missed from work.
