12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The City wants to construct a modern public safety facility to function as an Emergency Operations Center (EOC) for the community in the event of natural or man-made disaster. The facility would also house the City of Belle Isle Police Department and provide a host of public safety services and disaster mitigation functions. The City's population is under 10,000; however being a suburb of Orlando, crime spills over into our City. Further, the City is immediately adjacent to Orlando International Airport (MCO) and provides emergency backup response to MCO. Well-designed police facilities enable staff to perform their duties efficiently, effectively, and securely.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This project will accommodate the Police Department, Emergency Operations Center, Armory, and Evidence Storage, and Logistics at one central location, for investigation, and to provide security, safety, emergency response, and police presence. This facility will also position the department to deliver new and improved police and public services that were not previously possible.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Enhanced police presence and emergency response including increased community crime prevention educational opportunities,; increased opportunities for Community Oriented Policing; a work environment conducive to employee wellness, productivity and retention of the best officers; improved police training and improved community event and critical incident management capability. Enhanced police presence and emergency response.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

City of Belle Isle residents of which approximately 15% are economically disadvantaged residents; >800 residents anticipated to be served



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e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Having a new police facility/Emergency Operations Center will provide the necessary facility for training, community outreach, community policing, public safety during disasters, and to deter crime and alleviate crime in the area; less arrests. Documentation of responses/reductions/assistance.

The process of measuring the success of the police is not straightforward, but we expect crime rates; number of arrests and fines; clearance rates; and response times to be reduced, but also expect that it can reduce or prevent social disorder, and construct and maintain community relations

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalty clauses for missing milestones or not maintaining adequate progress, thus endangering performance of the contract; penalties might include reduction and/or loss of State appropriation including liquidated damages of a predetermined sum to be paid to the City.
