The project scope would include geotechnical and civil engineering services, removal of all unsuitable underlying soils, replacement of sub-base material, replacement of base rock material, repair/replacement of existing stormwater infrastructure within the project limits, and adjustments to existing sidewalks (and as necessary, regrading of the existing roadway slopes and resurfacing of asphalt pavement). The city is looking for funding to design and construct these projects.
