The Boynton Beach Police Department is looking to create a multi-layered crime prevention posture throughout the City. The funding request will focus on the parks and surrounding areas. This comprehensive posture will include implementing standardized security layers to include cameras, emergency call boxes, and licenses plate readers that will be tied to the department's Real Time Crime Center. A major component of this project is ShotSpotter technology which detects gunfire in surrounding areas and Mutual Link technology that enables community -wide multimedia sharing of communications. The regional impact comes from the inter connectivity between suspects from other regions within the area and the popularity of the City's parks to many who live outside of the city. These impacted neighboring areas can be categorized as high or increasing crime rates.
