Increase the number of children engaged in health and wellness programs; Increase the number of children involved in physical fitness activities; Reduce the childhood obesity rate; and Increase the amount of children engaged in nature.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Engage children in wilderness education programs and park experiences; Expand community gardening in the neighborhood; Engage children in robust fitness activities including year-round comprehensive athletics programs; Provide nutrition and healthy cooking lessons; and Increase access to healthy meals. Bee keeping and nature excursions will also be apart of the programming.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Engaging children and their families in physical fitness programs; Providing nutrition education and healthy cooking lessons to children and families; Expanding community gardening in the neighborhoods; and Working with neighborhood youth to develop and operate businesses for growing, packaging, marketing and selling fresh produce.

At-risk children and families in five of Florida's most disadvantaged neighborhoods as recognized by state statute.
