4. Project/Program Description

The Mikey Goodwin Playground will be a community-built and community-funded ADA-compliant and inclusive playground named in honor of Mikey Goodwin. The playground will be constructed of structural PVC lumber and other materials manufactured to withstand the salt water environment to which Nance Park is subjected. It will feature equipment that is ADA-compliant and inclusive to kids within a wide age range and varying physical and cognitive abilities. The goal of the Indialantic Playground Advisory Committee is to provide the community with a playground that will be as inclusive as possible to all people and all abilities while getting the most from the relatively small budget. The community-build approach was determined to be the most cost effective way to achieve this goal. Not only does it save on construction costs, it provides a sense of community ownership and community pride while bringing Town residents together for a week-long event during Build Week.

The specific goal is to make the playground as ADA accessible and inclusive as possible. Any funds received would be used for items such as unitary safety surfacing (ultimate mobility accessibility); zip-line structures that include a seat to accommodate people with physical disabilities; swing set; and sensory equipment for people on the autism spectrum.

The desired ADA- compliant equipment will meet the intended purpose of these funds.

This playground will provide a place for people with a wide range of disabilities to enjoy the oceanside environment and play alongside able-bodied people.

Nance Park is a public park with public parking open to any and all visitors to Indian River County. The target population is anyone who seeks a playground regardless of physical and cognitive abilities.

The expected benefit is to provide an enriching and fun location for people of all abilities to enjoy.
