Any funds received would be used for items such as unitary safety surfacing (ultimate mobility accessibility); zip-line structures that include a seat to accommodate people with physical disabilities; swing set; and sensory equipment for people on the autism spectrum.

This playground will provide a place for people with a wide range of disabilities to enjoy the oceanside environment and play alongside able-bodied people.

Nance Park is a public park with public parking open to any and all visitors to Indialantic. The target population is anyone who seeks a playground regardless of physical and cognitive abilities.

The expected benefit is to provide an enriching and fun location for people of all abilities to enjoy.
