##### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To increase public access to Jennings State Forest from Clay County and to further the goal of connecting the NE Florida Greenway corridor from Duval County in the north to Putnam County in the south.

##### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Design and construction of greenway trails.

##### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Increased opportunities for outdoor recreation and greenspace preservation.

##### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will benefit the general population and serve citizens countywide (218,245 people).

##### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefits include improved quality of life, opportunities for outdoor recreation and exercise, and greenspace preservation. Surveys and the county's parks and recreation app will be used to measure greenways usage. The greenways will be maintained by the county and evaluated regularly by Parks and Recreation staff.

##### f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?



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The local government is responsible for conforming with all federal and state regulations governing the program.
