Federally designated state coalitions receive approximately \$350,000 from the federal government to coordinate statewide service improvements and address emerging issues. A state match of \$350,000 would leverage federal funds for FPEDV to provide essential technical assistance and training for Florida's 41 certified domestic violence centers on issues that affect domestic violence survivors.

Technical assistance and training will also improve victim access to relevant resources as well as promote cooperation between Florida's 41 certified Domestic Violence providers.
