12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The regional license plate reader program will enhance our community policing efforts, Homeland Security, and help to deter criminal activity in Broward County, which has almost 2 million residents. License Plate Readers will assist the City in capturing criminals coming into the City and exiting the City, especially onto major highways. This would improve economic activity in the region because more people would feel safe traversing the areas. The City has large Corporate Parks, Sawgrass Mills, and the BB&T Center, which all attract tens of millions of visitors to the City of Sunrise annually.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



This is a regional program for the greater Broward County area, which has approximately 2 million residents and 40 million visitors to the area each year. The City of Sunrise has the second largest tourist population in the state of Florida behind Disney World. We are home to the largest outlet mall, Sawgrass Mills, along with the FLA Live (BB&T Arena), which seats close to 20,000 patrons and is the host to more than 100 Panthers Hockey games and concerts each year. Both of these tourist attractions are very close to the County's major highways.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

The purpose of this regional program is to deter crime and to solve crimes once they have occurred. The outcome will be measured by the City's crime rate and the rate that criminal cases are solved in the area. The City is centrally located in Broward County and this program can be utilized as a regional crime solving tool once the license plate readers are installed.

We expect to be able to see a reduction in the amount of crime and in increase in the number of crimes solved in the region. Crimes and crimes being solved are very measurable and can be reported frequently.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If the license plate readers are not installed and functional, then the City should not receive the funding allocated.
