12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Hardening of aging stormwater infrastructure for a resilient system, and to be better prepared to manage ever increasing flood events.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Rehabilitate and harden two stormwater pump stations that are critical for Weston's flood control. Extend service life of critical underwater infrastructure. Rehabilitate and harden building structures to protect pump facilities inside buildings during and after a hurricane event. Replace deteriorated noise walls, minimizing noise pollution to the surrounding residential communities (including our neighbors in Southwest Ranches). Upgrade fuel systems to provide operational redundancy. Overhaul pump station engines for improved performance, reliability, and environmental impact. Rework and stabilize canal banks with new riprap.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Upgrades completed will increase the service life of the infrastructure, allowing for continued flood protection to residents.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All residents located within the boundaries of the City of Weston's Indian Trace Development District, a total population of approximately 55,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit: Flood protection due to ever increasing amount of storm events and with higher than normal precipitation. This project will minimize the risk of flooding, including repeat flooding, to protect property and life.
Measure: Increased service life of existing infrastructure, and reliability of equipment to efficiently remove stormwater during flood events. Maintain operational status during and after storm events. Minimize costs for damage resulting from flooding and other related causes.



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f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Upon failure of Contractor to obtain Substantial Completion, Contractor shall pay to City the sum of Thirteen hundred dollars (\$1,300.00) for each day after the deadline for Substantial Completion. After Substantial Completion, Contractor shall pay to City the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for each day after the deadline for Final Completion, until final completion is obtained.
