### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Repairing roadways with significant wear and tear due to elements, dense muck sediments due to unique topography of the glades region, and heavy agricultural transport that service everyday transportation needs for residential traffic in the Western Communities, as well as comprise one of the critical agricultural transportation hubs in the state.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Street resurfacing and reconstruction.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Safe, well-constructed roads are essential to supporting agriculture-dependent local economy and the \$3 billion agricultural industry. Land transportation corridors are the key component of the supply chain of the entire region and serve as the primary delivery mode for both final product and supply required to cultivate surrounding fields.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The local population has experienced one of the highest unemployment rates in the state since increased automation related to cultivating the fields began to reduce the need for seasonal and year-round ready availability of manual labor. Improvements in local transportation have been the key factor in attracting direct investment to the area resulting in steady employment opportunities for the entire Glades Area population totaling approximately 25,000 residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increased public safety, improved response time carrying out fire rescue and law enforcement missions, increased local business and sales tax revenues that accompany safe and well built infrastructure, and the entire local small business ecosystem that supports it, and lower unemployment and associated social costs such as crime and substance abuse resulting in improved public health.
