a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal and purpose of this project is to better prepare our students to be college and career ready by combining academics with exposure to careers. This gives them an early opportunity to explore their talents and gain experience that will set them on a path to successful collegiate careers.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The proposed expansion of COHEA is to broaden its career-pathways program to incorporate authentic classrooms and labs for instruction in EMR, EMT, EKG, and Phlebotomy; Mass Communications videography, cinematography, and editing; Criminal Justice 911 Dispatch: and STEM design, robotics, 3D manufacturing, and coding. These requested funds will be spend on an additional wing to the school. The expansion will better provide realistic training and strategies to support students in acquiring academic, employability, and technical skills that is demanded of the current and future workforce.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The requested funds will be spent on an additional wing to provide students in our community the opportunity to receive authentic instruction in a real-world simulated environment to enhance their learning experiences and increase their employment opportunities. Also, the expansion will provide the needed space for additional students to attend and benefit from our unique career pathways municipal charter school.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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The City of Hialeah community, children, parents, continuing education program from Miami-Dade College, teachers and residents will be served by this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected result will be that additional students from our community will be able to enroll from an already extended waiting list. The added building will include authentic simulation labs and classrooms for Emergency Medical Responder, Mass Communication, Criminal Justice, and STEM. The methodology used to measure the outcome of this project is the FSA for academic assessment, career-pathways assessment such as the state certified exams, Adobe certification exams, the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) for Criminal Justice, and the FDLE Basic Abilities Test (BAT) exam.
