### 12. Program Performance

### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

We have many issues in our county which are health-related, including growing rates of diabetes and obesity in children. Programs like PAL work with youth in Martin County to encourage healthier lifestyles through physical activity. There are fewer opportunities for students to get exercise through physical education or organized sports, we offer an avenue for the youth to explore other sports and activities. Most research shows replacing academic lessons with physical activity does not have a detrimental impact on school grades – in fact some research shows increased participation in physical activity leads to better grades. With on site counselors and an open door policy our youth will have access to the help.

### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The facility will provide Athletic, leadership and mental health programming for youth ages 8-17. In the athletics department we will have Boxing, Wrestling, Weightlifting, Volleyball, Football (indoor Soccer), Soccer, Karate. In the leadership avenue we will have Youth leadership round-tables, Teamwork field trips, Mentorship and mental health counseling. We will also have a music program with a Drumline team for middle school and high school students.

### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This Community center will also be open to the public when not in use by PAL programming. Programs and organizations who specialize in Early learning, parental classes and community growth initiatives will be allowed to use this space for the betterment of the community.

### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

We are targeting middle to low income families and at-risk youth. We are expected to impact over 500 youth per year in our programming and their families.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



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### be measured?

Outcome measures are arrived at by measuring the following data: Within the past 12 months:

- -How many youths were assessed for juvenile diversion programs
- -How many successfully completed all sanctions thus having their charges dismissed for filing by the state attorney or avoiding alternative educational placement
- -How many were unsuccessful in fulfilling sanction thus receiving form

Funds will returned on a prorated amount if deliverables are not met.
