12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The project consists of the connection of existing residential dwelling unit septic systems located in the Chassahowitzka/Homosassa springshed to Citrus County's central wastewater collection system. The construction will include installation of a new sanitary sewer collection system to the resident's lot lines and any associated components which many include lift station(s) and grinder pump stations. The County's requirements will then result in the connection of up to 135 residents and a total of 327 lots.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The permitting, design and construction of a central wastewater collection system made available to the residents in the project area.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Residential homes currently on OSTDS will be provided with the availability to connect to the County's central wastewater collection system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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The resource benefit of the water quality project will allow for the reduction of pollutant loads to the Homosassa River and springshed, a SWIM priority water body by an estimated 3,365 lbs/yr TN for all the residential lots located within the project limits. This project will compel the connection of up to 327 lots with up to 150 connections that are along the Homosassa River, a first magnitude spring. The County has a mandatory connection ordinance in place (Citrus County Code of Ordinances, Part II, Chapter 42

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project benefit will be the reduction of pollutant loads to the Homosassa/Chassahowitzka Springs Groups by an estimated amount of 3,365 lbs/yr TN.

The number of residential connections to the County's wastewater collection system will be used as the methodology used to measure the benefit of the project. These homes will then be subject to the County's mandatory connection ordinance.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Withholding reimbursement payments from the grantee until all measurables are met per the contract is a major financial burden that any municipality or other entity can afford to bear. This method or penalty ensures that all performance measures and deliverables are met during and after the project.

13. The owners of the facility to receive, directly or indirectly, any fixed capital outlay funding. Include the relationship between the owners of the facility and the entity.

Citrus County, Florida and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection are currently working together on Springs Initiative goal specific projects that are either in the design phase or the construction phase. These projects are concurrent with the goals set forth in the Chassahowitzka/Homosassa BMAP of reducing nutrient loading to the groundwater and surface waters associated with the first magnitude springs.
