To provide the ability to improve the quality of the stormwater runoff that is discharged into the receiving waters through removal of debris, build-up, silt, trash and unwanted material from the open ditches

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This purchase improve efficiency, help to reduce potential contamination of receiving waters and drinking water supply, reduce flooding, provide a greater level of service to our residents, reduced costs, and improved appearance of the City in general.

All citizens of the City, population 8,564, and visitors may benefit from this project.
