The project eliminates the existing walkway/greenway gap on the south side of C-13 Canal (Middle River Canal) between the existing walkway trail on east of NW 32 Way and the walkway trail on the west of SR-7.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This proposed greenway/walkway trail project solves the discontinuity of the walkway/greenway trail on the south R/W of SFWMD C-13 Canal from the existing walkway on the west of SR-7 to the east of NW 32 Way. The project is the best solution to provide a walking and biking facility along the south R/W of SFWMD C-13 Canal.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Walkway/greenway trail to the east and also to the west facilitating easy biking/walking from the neighborhood to the adjacent schools.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Elderly persons, grade and high school students. The Greenway Trail will provide a safer commute for the people in the adjacent neighborhood, traveling to and from school, work, recreation, and day to day activities. It will strengthen the community by providing more opportunities for people to walk or access public transportation to connect to these facilities as well as connecting with other people in the community. The city has a large senior citizen population with limited access to transportation. The project will address the needs of those senior citizens' access and also the city's overall public health goals, as new Greenway Trail will encourage people to walk more instead of driving to nearby businesses.

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The Greenway Trail will encourage people to walk more instead of driving to nearby schools and businesses. It will facilitate a healthy environment by providing a walking/biking trail.
