12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

High fidelity simulation prepares the student by immersing them in real-world experiences in a life-like setting. For learning to meet the needs of all students it must be taught in three ways (Auditory, Visual, and Hands On). The simulation will better prepare students to pass the NCLEX exam to obtain their license.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Herzing University will measure the student exams against the simulation experience to determine level of improvement in overall scores. Ultimately, the simulation experience will better prepare the students to pass the NCLEX on the first attempt (another measurement we will report)

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Herzing University provides front-line healthcare workers through various nursing programs in Hillsborough and Orange counties. The Simulation Center will also be available to hospitals and EMT organizations for continuing education of staff.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Orlando and Tampa campuses service over 800 students. As the majority of these students fill critical nursing roles in their communities, the population impact is much greater.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



Herzing University expects improvement in the first-time pass rates of Nursing students. Herzing University will measure the impact of Simulation learning on didactic examinations, NCLEX pass rates and student retention.
