The goal of this project is to provide the city a safe and updated emergency command center for the police department, fire department, and City Council as well as an updated City Hall for the citizens of Chattahoochee.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

An existing building will be purchased and renovated to meet the desired needs of an emergency command center and City Hall.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The city currently does not have an emergency command center and the existing City Hall is antiquated and is too small to serve the basic needs of the city. Therefore, this project would provide the citizens with a larger, more convenient City Hall and the command center would provide the necessary equipment for the police chief, fire chief, and city officials.
