This project will minimize bank erosion and siltation of multiple ditch bank systems. The City tracks bank erosion issues within the Mobility Department, Operations division. This project will provide an enhanced conveyance system to the receiving water body, minimize erosion of the ditch banks and minimize siltation of the conveyance system. The ditches are monitored by the Mobility Department, Storm water Operations Division. A matrix has been developed to evaluate the severity of the erosion and frequency needed to stabilize the system.
