12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The overall goal of FCC USA is to use Soccer as a to tool to bring physical, social and emotional engagement, to promote mental health wellbeing, and create social impact to vulnerable children and youth using trauma and resilience-informed approach with evidence based strategies. The aim is to build protective buffers and develop emotional resilience in children and youth, as well as strengthening their support system by offering referral linkages to children and youth and their families.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Students will receive services through our afterschool program. Children and youth will also learn healthy relationship skills, social emotional learning techniques, effective communication skills, financial literacy, goal setting skills, civic engagement and community outreach activities where they can serve community hours.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Students will receive an evidence based integrated methodology of soccer and social emotional education, that is both trauma and resilience informed, about the aforementioned subjects. Students will have a minimum of 2,160 minutes of education through our afterschool program.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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The target population who will be served through Project FCC USA are economically disadvantaged/ at risk children and youth (ages 4 to 17).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefits of this project include improving the physical, mental, emotional and social well being of participants along with increasing economic self sufficiency. The following outcomes will be measured:

- % of students who complete the mental and emotional wellness workshop will show awareness of important emotional self and co regulating strategies needed to develop thriving skills.
- % of students who complete the financial literacy workshop and career and educational success workshop will indicate intent to pursue their educational goals.
- % of children and youth indicate knowledge of developing healthy relationships;
- % of children and youth indicate feeling empowered to make healthy decisions;
