4. Project/Program Description

Execute a feasibility study, PD&E, and prepare for funding to widen SR 200/A1A from County Road 107 to the Amelia Island Parkway. This project will include major intersection improvements at SR,200/CR 107 and SR 200/Amelia Island Parkway. This project will also include the widening of the Shave Bridge from 4 lanes to 6 lanes. This project should be designed with the Trans Nassau Multi-use Trail project as a critical component and driver of the cross-section. This segment of SR 200/A1A is part of the SIS and is of critical state concern. In 2021, the FDOT completed widening SR 200/A1A from I-95 to CR 107. At the intersection of SR 200/A1A and CR 107, the roadway reduces down to 4 lanes. Completing the widening project to the intersection with the Amelia Island Parkway, the primary driver decision point, allows roadway capacity to be maintained.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The study would determine the feasibility of funding the widening of SR 200 from CR 107 to Amelia Island Parkway, including intersection improvements at either end. It is expected that this project will help determine whether widening will also alleviate existing operational traffic failures at the intersection of SR 200 and CR 107 as part of the bottle necking down to 4 lanes.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A study will be performed to outline feasibility for the construction of the project.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

If the study determines it is feasible to widen the roadway, the citizens will be provided an improved transportation network with increased capacity to support the rapidly growing population of Nassau County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project benefits all 80,000 residents of Nassau County and the 1.5 million tourists that visit Amelia Island annually.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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If determined feasible, this project is expected to provide additional capacity on the segment of SR 200 connecting CR 107 to Amelia Island Parkway. Much of the volume is expected to divert to Amelia Island Parkway, allowing for the remaining traffic to utilize the existing 4 lanes from Amelia Island Parkway eastward. This improvement can be measured directly through comparing volume to capacity ratios, measuring level of service, determining free-flow speed, or resident surveys.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Standard contract penalties are sufficient.
