a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Raise awareness about careers in the skilled workforce and directly provide emerging students with entry-level skills training and work experience prior to entering the private workforce.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This project will support the Leon Works Expo and Junior Apprenticeship Program, an expansion of Leon County's internship offerings in skilled career fields.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Leon Works Expo provides opportunities for citizens to connect with workforce training opportunities and engage with prospective employers. Students gain valuable work experience through the Junior Apprenticeship Program.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Junior Apprenticeship program targets local high school students and students currently enrolled in local colleges and technical centers. In addition, through the Leon Works Expo, the program also seeks to raise awareness about skilled careers among high school students and other area residents who may be unemployed, underemployed, or who may be seeking a career change.

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Increased employment in the local/regional skilled workforce; also increased number of local career/technical education students gaining workplace experience prior to entering the skilled workforce.
