To purchase equipment neccessary to reduce the extent and duration of flooding in the City of North Lauderdale

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Installation of the C-14 stormwater pump station to prevent backflow from the C-14 into the City's canal system, to allow floodwaters to discharge into the C-14 at a reasonable rate and to allow the City to prepare for a storm by lowering canal elevations in advance of a storm providing more storage

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A significant decrease in flooding extent and duration of the City's roadway and properties within the City

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Citizens of North Lauderdale - 44794

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit will be a significant decrease of flooding extent and duration in the City of North Lauderdale once the canal system is controlled by a pump station so the canal levels can be lowered to add more volume for the stormwater run off. This will be measured by the number of documented road closures for safety concerns and amount of property damage.
