Homosassa River is a first magnitude spring and designated Outstanding Florida Waterway which is identified as a priority waterbody by SWIM. It is listed as impaired for nutrients & filamentous algae by FDEP & USEPA. The goal is to restore water quality through removal of algal detrital material and planting SAV
