a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds requested would be utilized to construct a state of the art facility with the needed infrastructure to house a regional partnership between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and local law enforcement agencies that can specialize in finding and recovering endangered and missing individuals.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

With these funds and the construction of a state of the art facility, law enforcement agencies will be able to request cutting edge collaboration in a combined effort to locate those individuals that are missing and have been unable to be located. As a result of these funds, the partnership that can be created would ultimately become an incubator for cutting edge technology and methods for locating endangered and missing individuals.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

As described above, individuals would be serviced through the development of cutting edge investigative methods for locating endangered and missing individuals as well as direct collaboration with law enforcement agencies locally, statewide, and nationally.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served would be law enforcement agencies requiring assistance locating endangered and missing individuals, and thus by extension, those families desperate to find their missing loved one and the citizenry at large which would benefit from the development of additional effective techniques.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?



With this center, the expectation is that Pasco residents, as well as the state as a whole, will benefit from the collaboration of law enforcement agencies to create this regional partnership that can focus specifically on locating endangered and missing individuals as well as developing new and improving current methodologies. These benefits can be measured by the number of endangered and missing cases that are solved after collaboration.

Failure to utilize the funds in the method outlined in this request would result in return of funds to the state.
