12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The implementation of a dedicated law enforcement unit within Leon County committed to combating human trafficking. Leon County is home to the capitol of Florida, multiple universities, historic sites, parks, museums, hotels, restaurants, many massage parlors, US27 and the I-10 corridor. These factors present law enforcement officials with a challenging environment and an increasing need to effectively identify and combat Human Trafficking.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be used to support three full-time Deputy/Detective positions. Services will include, but are not limited to, criminal investigative services, missing persons recovery, and referral services for victims.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens will include, but are not limited to, criminal investigative services, missing persons recovery, and access to referral services through our community wellness portal (SPIRIT program) to victim service programs they need to recover and rebuild their lives. Direct services may extend to the identification/referral of local diversion programs for victimized youth.

The Human Trafficking Unit will provide direct services, education, awareness, and referral services for victims, aiming to reduce the number of incidences. Leon County will have a focused target for HT convictions and have the tools to ensure, once incarcerated, HT's are not able to continue.
