12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will extend the City's existing wastewater system further west along US Highway 90 up to Woodberry Road. By doing so, any future development along US Highway 90 and the residents of Woodberry Road will have access to central sewer services. With the new system, additional homes and business will be allowed to locate in this area without the need for on-site septic systems.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Design and construction of the sewer line extension. There are greater than 20 businesses and 50 homes in the proposed project area. An estimated 4,000 people will be served by this project.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The City does not currently provide sewer services to this area. All businesses and residential developments are serviced by on-site septic systems. The proposed project would make sewer available in this area to existing users as well as any future developments. Future residential and commercial growth in this area is eminent, therefore, access to a water system critical. Capacity for future growth will be included in the design of the system to accommodate additional commercial and residential development in this area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

There are greater than 20 businesses and 50 homes in the proposed project area. An estimated 4,000 people will be served by this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Immediate benefits of this project are the expansion of facilities for a long-time hardware store, wherein they will more than double their daily employees from 15 to 40 staff. The Woodberry Community will immediately have the sewer availability to grow from a 50 home community to at least 110 homes without use of on-site septic systems. Four fire hydrants will be added and an increase of water pressure needed for the county's largest employer. There will be an immediate improvement in the revenue base for the city. The City will have record of new sewer connections associated with this project.

The City will work with the contracting agency to determine applicable measures should funding be made available.
