North Bay is an integral component of the St. Andrew Bay estuarine system. This project will eliminate current and future discharges from septic systems into North Bay which will protect the public and environment from harmful nutrients and bacteria. This will substantially improve water quality and enhance marine life in North Bay and the St. Andrew Bay estuarine system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

An engineering and design team will be selected to produce all the necessary documents for the purposed septic-to-sewer conversion. A construction engineering inspector will be selected to insure quality and compliance during bid and construction phases. A qualified contractor will then be selected to construct the project in accordance with all state and local regulations.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The availability of central sewer services and increased water quality in North Bay which is an integral part of the St. Andrew Bay watershed which supports numerous fisheries and has a high recreational value.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Every citizen and tourist that visits Bay County and enjoys the marine resources of the St. Andrew Bay estuarine system.

This project will remove and prevent the installation of septic systems in lowing lying coastal areas that often fail due to the high ground water table and flooding. The number of septic systems eliminated and prevented from being installed in the project area and the improvements in ambient water quality (nutrients, bacteria, chlorophyll-a) in North Bay and the St. Andrew Bay estuarine system will be used to measure the outcome of this project.

All County contracts include liquidated damages for not completing projects on schedule.
