12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Construction of Phase 1 (9 acres) of the 53-acre Bay Park, with a specific focus on environmental and water quality improvements to mitigate for the 70 million + gallons per year of untreated stormwater from parking and US41 that drains into the Sarasota Bay.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will assist in the construction of Phase 1 of The Bay Park, which will provide recreation opportunities, and access to community events, for people of all ages, incomes and ethnicities. The funding will be focused on water quality as noted above.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Passive and active recreation, programmed and education events, and other activities at a community park.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population to be served will be elderly persons, preschool, grade school, high school and university/college students, as well as families and users of all ages, ethnicities and incomes. Multiple thousands of individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Enhanced/improved environment or quality as measured by the pretreatment of currently untreated storm water before the project, and treated stormwater after completion; existing water quality has been measured pre-treatment and will be measured/monitored post treatment to evaluate/verify biological success. Increased/improved economic activity and tourism as measured by before and after attendance at the Park and out-of-state attendees and dollars spent; creation of specific immediate job opportunities as measured by actual jobs during the project construction, and jobs created by new events after the Park opening.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Withholding payment until satisfactory completion, as well as access to the required performance bond.

The Bay Park Conservancy is the agent consistent with the Partnership Agreement with the City of Sarasota executed April 24, 2019. The City of Sarasota is the owner.
