The purpose of this project is to extend potable infrastructure and fire hydrants into unincorporated areas for fire protection and increase the public safety through fire protection

The construction of approximately 39,823 linear feet of potable water mains and approximately 113 fire hydrants within unincorporated areas.

The unincorporated areas do not currently have fire hydrants on the streets. This project would greatly increase public safety as it would increase fire suppression.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population would be those currently residing in and adjacent to the unincorporated areas.

The expected benefit will be fire suppression in the unincorporated areas and the reduced risk of fire spreading from the unincorporated area to the adjacent neighborhoods.
